We are a privately owned business and have started trading as of this year 2024. We are providing services to utility companies such as remedial and survey works within the gas industry.

Karlson utilities policy on slavery and human trafficking

We are committed to ensuring that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking within our supply chains or in any part of our business. Due diligence processes as part of our initiative to identify and mitigate risk:

- Karlson Utilities office-based staff which ensures that we work within current employment legislation and best practice when recruiting. We work in partnership with agencies who are obliged to work within current employment legislation and meet our due diligence requirements.
- Karlson Utilities geographical scope of business is within the UK and all our sites are effectively and closely supervised.
- Karlson Utilities where possible build long standing relationships with suppliers and service providers and make clear our expectations of business behaviour
- Karlson Utilities have in place systems to encourage the reporting of concerns and the protection of whistleblowers.
- Karlson Utilities encourage employees to raise any concerns they may have.

Supplier adherence to our Values

Karlson Utilities have zero tolerance to slavery and human trafficking. We expect all those in our supply chain and subcontractors to comply with our values.
